

INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES AND MATERIALS

Educational videos are those which were developed for use in the educational setting for the purpose of introducing and/or reinforcing concepts and skills taught in the curriculum. They may be used as a supplemental resource to enhance instruction. They may be used to support the directed instruction of the teacher and shall not be used in lieu of instruction by the teacher.

Educational videos must be age appropriate to the learner. All videos used in the classroom setting shall be previewed by the teacher prior to viewing by the students.

Video recordings of movies produced for entertainment shall include, but not be limited to, movie rentals and video productions of television programs for entertainment. The use of movie and video productions of television programs for entertainment. The use of movie and video tapes for the purpose of entertainment, reward, or incidental learning shall be used in accordance with applicable copyright viewing restrictions of law, and shall be scheduled so as to not usurp the regular academic classes of students.

Movies shall be age appropriate. No movies may be shown to students in grades 4K – 5 which require parental guidance without written permission from the parent. Only movies that are relevant to curriculum and been approved by the principal shall be shown in class.
